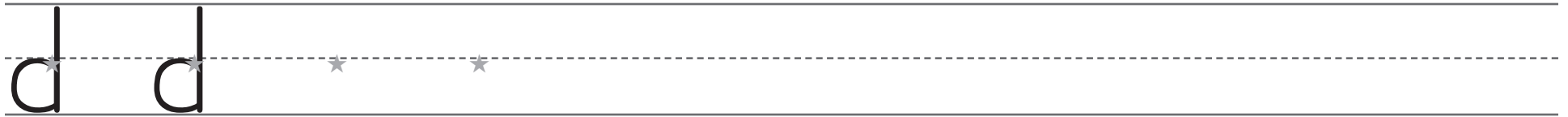
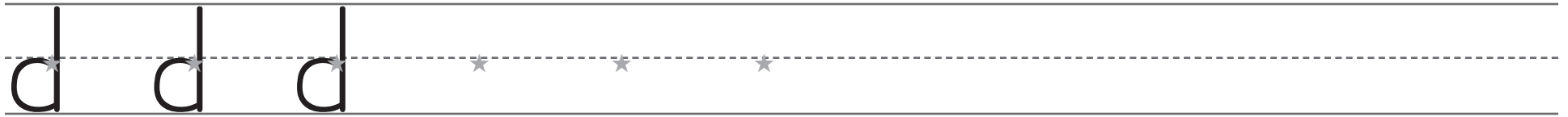


The Curve Letter "d"

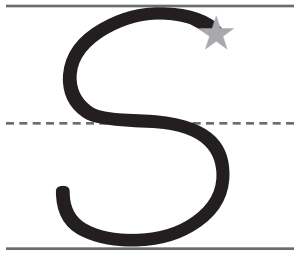

Instructions
